

PRIME MINISTER

ANGLO-ITALIAN SUMMIT

You start with a tête-à-tête with Craxi from 1000 to 1130. I attach cards listing the points to cover.

Foreign Ministers and Ambassadors join you at 1130.

At 1200 you go down to the Cabinet Room for the plenary session. You will want to invite Ministers to report in turn.

At 1245 you adjourn for lunch, which will be round the big table in the dining room. (We are proposing to put Craxi opposite you, in the belief that you will have had enough of him by then.) Since it is a working occasion, there is no need for a speech. You may like to do a loyal toast to The Queen and to the President.

At 1445 you go through to No.12 Downing Street for the Press Conference. I attach a draft opening statement. The Press Conference should finish at 1530. You then take leave of Signor Craxi at the front door.
